Only one percent of our nation's eligible population answers the call to serve in the United States Armed Forces, and those that do answer the call put their civilian lives on hold to protect and defend the United States. The Donors feel very strongly about supporting veterans after their military service ends. The University has a long affinity with veterans with classrooms once filled with WW2 veterans on the GI Bill, and then later with the post 9/11 generation of veterans. The Donors know the transition from military service to civilian life can be fraught with many obstacles, including the financial gap between GI benefits and the cost of higher education and they hope to bridge the gap with this scholarship.

- 2) Be a student that has served honorably while on active duty in the armed forces of the United States.
- 3) Demonstrate financial need as determined by current UM need analysis policies upon receipt of a processed current Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and CSS College Board Profile\*.
