To qualify for the Nicaraguan Student Scholarship you must:

- 1) Be of Nicaraguan heritage or born in Nicaragua
- 2) Be a United States citizen or permanent resident
- 3) Be working toward a first baccalaureate degree at the University of Miami enrolled in a select major (see 2<sup>nd</sup> page)
- 4) Be in good academic standing with the University (2.0 Cumulative GPA or higher)
- 5) Demonstrate financial need as determined by current UM need analysis policies upon receipt of a processed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and CSS College Board Profile

#### This is what you need to do:

- Include documentation for proof of your Nicaraguan heritage. Ex. passport, parent's birth certificate, or your own birth certificate.
- Complete and submit this application with required documentation on or before May 1<sup>st</sup>.
