- 4) Be in good academic standing with the University (2.0 Cumulative GPA or higher)
- 5) Demonstrate financial need as determined by current UM need analysis policies upon receipt of a processed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and CSS College Board Profile

This is what you need to do:

• Include documentation for proof of your Nicaraguan heritage. Ex. passport, parent's birth certificate, or your own birth certificate.
