To qualify for the Nicaraguan Students Endowed Scholarship you must:

- 1) Be of Nicaraguan heritage or born in Nicaragua
- 2) Be a United States citizen or permanent resident
- 3) Be working toward a first baccalaureate degree at the University of Miami enrolled in a select major (see 2<sup>nd</sup> page)
- 4) Be in good academic standing with the University (2.0 Cumulative GPA or higher)
- 5) Demonstrate financial need as determined by current UM need analysis policies upon receipt of a processed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and CSS College Board Profile

 Include documentation for proof of your Nicaraguan heritage. Ex. passport, parent's birth certificate, or your own birth certificate.
